

Healing the Culture Provides Pro-Life Guidance Each Monday in Lent

90 second videos answer tough questions on abortion and assisted suicide

Rapid City, SD, February 21, 2023— One of the greatest challenges the Church faces today is the corruption of sound moral philosophy with mainstream cultural trends and beliefs, particularly on issues concerning the value and dignity of human life. This Lent, the pro-life educational organization Healing the Culture will release six 90-second videos to help the faithful learn and teach others about God’s perspective on the sanctity of human life. Each Monday during Lent, a new video will present solid answers to some of the toughest questions on abortion and assisted suicide, and will be available at the newly launched website: [RespectLife.University](https://www.respectlifeuniversity.com).

“One great way to grow closer to God this Lent is to understand more deeply the miracle of human life and its inherent dignity and value,” said Camille Pauley, President and CEO of Healing the Culture. “Seeing ourselves the way God sees us changes everything.”

Each video lays out a pressing contemporary question such as, “Is the embryo a human being?”, “Can you be a human being but not a human person?”, and “Should we agree to disagree on abortion?” Pauley said that the answers in the videos are purposefully short, but also clear and to the point. “We wanted to counter the errors in mainstream thinking by presenting logical arguments that uphold human dignity rather than diminish it.” Topics will also include abortion and fetal abnormalities, pregnancies that threaten the mother’s life, and assisted suicide. “As Christians, we are called to love our neighbors without regard to age, abilities, or stage of development,” Pauley said. “These videos help viewers understand God’s love for the weak and vulnerable and reshape our vision for what it means to be human in the first place.”

Healing the Culture promotes the ethical treatment of human life at all stages through education.
